### WEEKDAY MASSES Monday, Tuesday and Friday Masses at 9am.

There is no longer need to make advance bookings for weekday Masses. Registration will take place at the door. **We ask that you arrive at least 15 minutes early to allow time for registration.**

### WEEKEND MASSES Saturday 6pm, Sunday 7.30am and 9.30am.

Each week, bookings for the **Weekend Masses** will be open from **12.30pm on the preceding Monday and close Fridays at 12.30pm**. Our present capacity at each Mass is 70 people.

Due to Health Department requirements for tracing in case of COVID-19, you will need to type in the name, address, email address and phone number of each person you are booking for (this includes children). There is no need to print off "tickets". The Welcomers will tick off your names when you arrive at the door. So that we keep safe-distancing, the Welcomer will need time to complete registration, without people being in a queue. **It would be helpful if you could arrive at least 15 minutes before Mass.**
